Aune Head Arts **recycles**, **reuses**, and **reduces** in as many ways as we possibly can.

We **reuse**:

- back sides of paper
- cardboard
- envelopes
- bubble wrap and other packaging
- blue tack and similar fixings
- foamcore and other materials that are hard to recycle
- plastic cutlery and cups when we use them for public events
- we use rechargeable batteries whenever possible, which is most of the time

We **recycle**:

- paper, plastic, card, glass, tetrapacks, and any other materials that can be recycled through municipal recycling schemes
- clear plastic (polyethylene)
- ink cartridges (these are sent to animal charity Blue Cross for re-use)
- CDs / DVDs
- computers and other technology when appropriate and possible

We use **recycled**:

- paper, envelopes and other stationary
- ink cartridges
- tissues and toilet paper, and any other paper products in this category

We use **non-toxic or non-chemical**:

- cleaning produces
- whiteboard markers
- glues / adhesives
- paint

We always **print** on recycled paper or card stock, using vegetable-dye inks

We **travel** by train or bus whenever possible and keep flying to an absolute minimum

We use **local food**, organic where possible, because we believe this kind of food minimises environmental impact
